The Trace Pace will give you an opportunity to begin conditioning your equines for the upcoming season. Here is how it works: A five section course including two walk sections, one trot section and two “any pace” sections will be set out. There are 3 main divisions: VSE, pony, and horse (singles and multiples are together) and 4 levels: training, preliminary, intermediate, and advanced. Training level completes 3 sections. Preliminary has *the option of completing 3 or 5 sections*. Intermediate and advanced complete all 5 sections.

Sections are marked, and drivers will know the optimal KPH for each section (ADS standards). However, the distance and optimal time for the course will not be given. It is up to you and your navigator to keep your own time and to have a sense of what the optimal pace is for your horse/pony/VSE. You will have a time card to fill out that will be turned in for scoring at the end. Ribbons will be given to 5th place in each division/level for the competitor who is closest to the optimal time overall. Volunteers will be available on the course and afterward to check P and R's at your request.

Start at 10:00 A.M. (5 minute intervals) *Order of go will be sent out by e-mail in advance and be posted at the Event.*

The attire is casual with helmets required.
